### Number of the Week- Year 1 Autumn 2

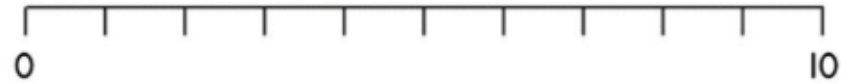
