We be focusing on living in the wider world. This will include learning about how we contribute to society, money, water safety and stealing. Our focus question this half term will be 'what is the Hajj and why is it so important to Muslims?'	Our Science focus this half term is energy. We will learn to associate the brightness of a lamp or the volume of a buzzer with the number and voltage of cells used in the circuit. We will compare and give reasons for variations in how components function, including the brightness of bulbs, the loudness of buzzers and the on/off position of switches. We will also use recognised symbols when representing a simple circuit in a diagram.	Our extended writing will take place every Thursday. There will also be cross-curricular write opportunities regularly.	In computing, we will be learning how to create spreadsheets. Key vocabulary: rows, data, spreadsheet, columns, formula, budget, chart, expense, format cell, format bar, probability, move cell tool, profit
