Year 2 Curriculum Overview (Spring 2 Term)

Literacy

Our topic this term will be 'Amazing Birds'.

We will be exploring various styles of writing, focussing on non-chronological reports and persuasion.

Big Writing

Our extended writing will take place every Friday. There will also be opportunities for children to write at length throughout the week.

PSHE

This term, in PSHE we will be focusing on Living in the Wider World.

PE

This term our PE sessions will take place on Monday mornings and Thursday afternoons. Please can you make sure that any earrings are taken out before school as we are unable to do this. Children will not be able to do PE with their earrings in.

'How did we learn to fly'

Our topic this half term is focussing on the influential people within the history of flight. We will be using this topic to develop our skills in many areas! Our key subjects this half term are History, English and DT.

Key vocabulary: design, create, build, model, evaluate, aviation.

Maths

Our daily maths sessions will focus on addition and subtraction, looking at bridging through a ten. We will also focus on fractions, exploring halves, quarters and thirds. In our Shape, Space and Measure lessons, we will focus on temperature.



Science

This term we will be exploring Life Cycles. We will notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults. Also we will find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival.

History

In History, we will be exploring the question 'How did we learn to fly?'. We will be investigating influential people throughout the history of aviation including the Wright brothers, Amelia Earhart, Bessie Coleman and Neil Armstrong!

Social, Moral, Spiritual and Cultural skills (SMSC)

This will be integrated throughout our topics.

Promoting our school values

Through our learning we will be learning about diversity and tolerance. We will be re-introducing our school values and incorporating them into our learning.

RE

In RE, we will be looking at Islam. We will be exploring the question: Why do Muslims believe it is important to obey God?

DT

Our topic this half term will be 'Mechanisms'. We will use our skills in designing, creating and evaluating our very own fairground wheel.

Computing

This half term we will be conducting a unit of work based around our 3D printer. We will be designing, creating and evaluating various objects throughout the term. Will use technology purposefully to manipulate and create digital and physical content.

Music

In Music, we will be exploring 'Dynamics, timbre, tempo and motifs', using our voices expressively and creatively to create motifs of Space!
