Scarlet Fever & Slap Cheek  NHS  One of the state of the	We have seen an increase in the number of cases of the slap cheek virus since we have returned to school after Easter. We have also had some cases of the more serious Scarlet Fever. As we are experiencing both, parents of children with the tell-tale red cheeks and rashes will be asked to collect their child and have the cause confirmed by a medical professional. Children with slap cheek can return to school as long a they are well and without a fever. If you or your child has scarlet fever, stay away from nursery, school or work for 24 hours after you take the 1st dose of antibiotics.
