## Year 2 Curriculum Overview (Summer 2 Term)

### Literacy

Our novel this term will be 'The wind in the willows'.

We will be using this story to apply our writing skills and write an animal adventure story. Our extended writing will take place every Friday.

### 'Do you like to be beside the seaside?'

Our topic this half term is focussing on coasts of the UK and what we find there. We will be using this topic to develop our skills in many areas! Our key subjects this half term are Geography, English and Science.

Key vocabulary: beach, coast, ocean, sea, channel, market

### Social, Moral, Spiritual and Cultural skills (SMSC)

This will be integrated throughout our topics.

#### Promoting our school values

Through our learning we will be learning about diversity and tolerance. We will be re-introducing our school values and incorporating them into our learning.

### RE

In RE, we will be looking at Judaism. We will be exploring the question: What aspects of life really matter?

### DT

Our topic this half term will be 'Mechanisms: Making a moving monster'. We will design a monster which will move using a linkage mechanism.

### PSHE

In PSHE, we will be looking at sex and relationships education.

We will learn:

- To name the main parts of the body including external genitalia (e.g. vulva, vagina, penis, testicles, anus).
- About growing and changing from young to old and how people's needs change
- To recognise that some things are private and the importance of respecting privacy; that parts of their body covered by underwear are private.

### Maths

Our daily maths sessions will focus on Statistics along with Position and Direction. We will also be revisiting numbers up to 100, addition, subtraction, as well as further developing our skills with multiplication and division.



### Science

This term we will be exploring Making Connections. We will explore materials and explain the terms reduce, reuse and recycle. We will be looking at the properties of various materials, then testing their suitability to become a plant pot.

### Computing

This half term we will focussing on 'Presenting Ideas'. Use technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content. While also developing our Online Safety skills.

### PE

This term our PE sessions will take place on Monday mornings and Thursday afternoons.

### Geography

In Geography, we will be learning about the physical features of the Jurassic Coast and how humans have interacted with this over time, including land use, settlements and tourism!.

### Music

In Music, we will be exploring 'Myths and Legends'. We will play tuned and untuned instruments musically, whilst experimenting with, creating, selecting and combining sounds using the interrelated dimensions of music
