<p>Our focus text for this half term is based on a classic fantasy novel, <i>The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe</i>. We will be analysing the text throughout the unit with an opportunity to write a narrative as well as looking at mythical creatures in non-chronological reports.</p>	<p>This half term we will be looking at time before moving onto place value and reading and writing numbers up to 1 million. We will also be learning to add and subtract larger numbers as well as understanding area and perimeter.</p>	<p>The main focus of our topic will be <i>Geography</i>. We will be focusing on the Alps where children will be able to locate some of the world's countries on a map as well as understanding key physical and human characteristics.</p> <p><b>Key vocabulary:</b> atlas, hemisphere, latitude, longitude, questionnaire, fold mountain, recreational land use</p>	<p>This term our PE sessions will take place on Monday morning and Wednesday afternoon with Mr Walmsley (Monday Mr Carlisle). Please can you make sure that any earrings and jewellery are taken out before school as we are unable to do this.</p> <p>Our focus this half term will be invasion games (hockey and rugby).</p>	<p>In French, we will be learning how to recognise and sort nouns by gender and number, and to explain the effect this may have on an adjective. We will also be modifying sentences to use the correct articles/pronouns (un/une and il/elle) according to gender.</p>

<p>We be focusing on relationships. This will include our class expectations, behaviour, inclusion and accepting others, emotions (anger), British Values and growth mindset.</p>	<p>In RE this term, we will be looking at the religion of Christianity. The question we will be exploring is: Why is it sometimes difficult to do the right thing? This unit will investigate Christian beliefs about forgiveness and reconciliation.</p>	<p>In Science, we will be looking at mixtures and separation of materials. Our investigation skill will focus on research with lots of opportunities to carry out investigations and observing over time. Children will use their knowledge of solids, liquids and gases to decide how mixtures might be separated.</p>	<p>Our extended writing will take place every week. There will also be cross-curricular write opportunities regularly.</p>	<p>In computing, we will be focusing on Coding and Online Safety. Children will start to code efficiently as well as have the opportunity to simulate a physical system.</p>
