Year 2 Curriculum Overview (Autumn 1 Term)

Literacy

Our topics for this term will focus on the text 'The Way Home for Wolf'

We will be exploring stories with a familiar setting, poetry and non-chronological reports.

Big Writing

Our extended writing will take place every Friday. There will also be opportunities for children to write at length throughout the week.

PSHE

This term, in PSHE we will be focusing on relationships.

PE

This term our PE sessions will take place on Wednesday mornings and Thursday afternoons. Please can you make sure that any earrings are taken out before school as we are unable to do this. Children will not be able to do PE with their earrings in.

'Who is the leader of the pack?'

Our topic this half term is looking at our relationships with others. We will be using this topic to develop our skills in many areas! Our key subjects this half term are English, Science and PSHE.

Key vocabulary:

Pack, leader, relationships, protect, collaboration, resilience.

Maths

Our daily maths sessions will focus on place value, addition and subtraction and partitioning. In our Shape, Space and Measure sessions, we will look at the 2-D and 3-D shapes



Science

This term we will be exploring habitats of living things and how they provide their basic needs. We will also explore and compare the differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive.

Geography

In Geography, we will be exploring the question 'Would you prefer to live in a hot or cold place?'. We will compare features of the North and South Poles, Africa and our local area. We will also learn the names and locations of the seven continents.

Social, Moral, Spiritual and Cultural skills (SMSC)

This will be integrated throughout our topics.

Promoting our school values

Through our learning we will be learning about diversity and tolerance. We will be re-introducing our school values and incorporating them into our learning.

RE

In RE, we will be looking at Christianity and God. We will be exploring the question: Does how we treat the world matter?

Computing

This half term we will focus on coding. We will be creating and debugging simple programs, while using logical reasoning to predict the behaviour of them.

Art

In Art, we will be using a range of materials to create a story. We will be developing our skills in drawing, painting and sculpture.
