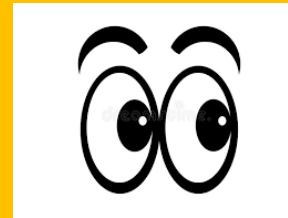
Our Listening Code: "Give me 5"

**Our teachers will use a 7-step
approach to help you make good
choices and support you with your
behaviour...**



1. Relate

Our teachers will have good relationships with all our children.
Our teachers will be consistent and provide high-quality teaching.

You will be rewarded (Dojos, marbles, stickers).
You will be praised when you do well and make good choices.





2. Remind

Your teacher's will praise you when you make good choices.

Your teacher's will remind you of our 3 rules:

***'Be Ready, Be Respectful,
Be Safe'.***





3. Final Reminder

Staff will support you by giving you a ‘final reminder’ to help make you aware of your behaviour choices and explain what the consequences will be if you continue with these behaviours.





4. Time in Calm Corner

You will be supported to have time in the calm corner in your classroom and be able to use the calm box resources.

You will also be able to speak any trusted adult in school.





5. Time in a Pod

You will be able to go to one of the pods in school to self-regulate and have some reflection time.

You will also be able to speak to a trusted adult when you are ready.





6. Individual Positive Reward Chart

If your teachers and senior leaders in school think it would be helpful for you to have an individual positive reward chart, they will talk to you and your parents about this and support you to earn rewards.





7. Pastoral Support Plan

A special plan called a Pastoral Support Plan may be used to support you to improve your social, emotional and behavioural skills. Targets will be set for you to work towards and the plan will be set with you, your teacher, your parents and Mrs Green.





Our 7 Step Approach





Staff will build strong relationships with all children

READY, RESPECT, SAFE will form part of classroom rules

School values will be the focus of conversations

Staff will model positive behaviour

Everyone's behaviour is a form of communication

Staff will provide lessons which are engaging and help you be the best you can be

Positive behaviour for learning will be rewarded

Staff will support you to repair relationships following any incidents

You will be reminded of expectations for behaviour regularly
