Our enquiry question this term is: **What did the Romans do for us?** Our key focus this half term will be developing our knowledge and skills in History and Science.

English	Maths	Knowledge Work	PE
In English this half term we are looking at a fiction texts about Boudicca, Queen of the Iceni. We will be creating our own narrative with our new leader of the Celts.	In Maths this half term we are learning about length and fractions. We will be exploring the part whole relationship finding fractions of amounts, exploring the difference between unit and non-unit fractions and adding fractions within a whole.	In History, our enquiry question is 'How have children's lives changed?' We will be exploring what life used to be like compared to modern Britain.	Our PE sessions will continue to take place on a Monday afternoon and a Tuesday morning. Please ensure long hair is tied back and all jewellery is removed before school unless children are able to do this independently.

In PSHE we will be exploring how we can stay healthy and spotting for hazards. We will be focusing on medicines and if things are safe to play with.	In RE we are studying Sikhism. Our key question is 'Why are the Gurus important to Sikhs?'	In Science, we will be learning about plant reproduction. We will be exploring parts of a plant and their functions.	In music this half term, we will be learning to play the ukulele. We will be learning how to perform in a solo and group contexts and use our instruments with accuracy and fluency.

In computing, we will be exploring simulations and how we can create a program, including how to debug it.	In French we are looking at different types of transport.	In Art this half term, we will be exploring different sculptures. We will construct a 3D structure out of joined 2D shapes.	Spellings will be sent out weekly and tested on a Monday.
