<p>In English this half term we are looking at the poem 'Spider and the Fly.' We are going to use the plot of this poem to write our own narrative with a moral.</p>	<p>In Maths this half term we are learning about time. Our key question is 'Why is family an important part of Hindu life?'</p>	<p>In Science, we will be applying our working scientifically skills to different experiments. We will be exploring the question 'Does hand span affect grip strength?'</p>	<p>In music this half term, we will be learning to play the ukulele. We will be learning how to perform in a solo and group contexts and use our instruments with accuracy and fluency.</p>
