Year 1 Curriculum Overview (Autumn 1 Term)

'Why are we proud Prestonians?'

The key subjects this half term include Art, Geography & Science

Key vocabulary: Aerial map, human features, seasons, weather, city, physical features, hill, forest.

Maths

Our daily maths sessions will focus on exploring the relationship between numbers and introduce children to the important concept of equivalence; focus on the correct use of comparative language, as well as use of mathematical symbols (<, = and >). In our Shape, Space and Measure sessions, we will focus on recognising, composing, decomposing and manipulating 2D and 3D shapes.



Science

This half term we will be thinking about changes within seasons. We will be using our observation skills to identify what changes over time. We will also be creating our own weather reports.

Geography

In Geography we will be looking at what it is like to live in Preston. We will be exploring aerial maps and creating our own maps for our school grounds.

Social, Moral, Spiritual and Cultural skills (SMSC)

This will be integrated throughout our topics.

Through our learning we will be learning about diversity and tolerance. We will be re-introducing our school values and incorporating them into our learning.

Computing

We will be looking at Technology Around Us. We will recognise technology in school and use it responsibly. We will also apply various techniques to convert 2D drawings into a 3D model. This will all be underpinned through our understanding of Online Safety.
