


E.g.</p>  <p style="text-align: center;">$11 + 9 = 20$</p> <p style="text-align: center;">$9 + 11 = 20$</p> <p style="text-align: center;">$20 - 11 = 9$</p> <p style="text-align: center;">$20 - 9 = 11$</p>	<p>Please have a go at using the knowledge of 'making ten' to add a one-digit number to a two-digit number E.g.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">$6 + 24 = 30$</p> <p style="text-align: center;">$8 + 52 = 60$</p> <p style="text-align: center;">$3 + 77 = 80$</p>	<p>Please have a go at finding ten more and ten less than a two-digit number. E.g.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">$23 + 10 = 33$</p> <p style="text-align: center;">$23 - 10 = 13$</p> <p style="text-align: center;">$56 + 10 = 66$</p> <p style="text-align: center;">$56 - 10 = 46$</p>	<p>Please have a go at using the knowledge of adding and subtracting tens to solve problems. E.g.</p> <p>Sarah has baked 36 cupcakes. She needs to bake 10 more. How many cupcakes will she bake?</p> <p>Adam has 62 marbles. He loses 10 of them. How many marbles does he have left?</p>	<p>Please have a go at using number facts to subtract a multiple of ten from a two-digit number E.g.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">$48 - 20 = 28$</p> <p style="text-align: center;">$56 - 30 = 26$</p> <p style="text-align: center;">$74 - 60 = 14$</p>	<p>Please have a go at using knowledge of adding and subtracting multiples of ten to solve problems E.g.</p> <p>Helen buys 43 books. She gives 30 away to a charity shop. How many books does she have left?</p>
