Year 2 Curriculum Overview (Spring 1 Term)

'Why is our world wonderful?'

Our topic this half term is focussing on our world and the wonderful things that we can find in it. We will be using this topic to develop our skills in many areas! Our key subjects this half term are English, Geography and PSHE.

Key vocabulary: continent, habitat, physical feature, human feature.

Maths

Our daily maths sessions will focus on representing repeated addition as multiplication. We will be focusing on the 2's, 5's and 10's times table's. We will also be focusing on length and height problems.



Science

This term we will be exploring Materials, particularly the uses of everyday materials. We will; identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard for particular uses

Geography

In Geography, we will be exploring the question 'Why is our world wonderful?'. We will be identifying features and major characteristics of the UK before learning about some of the amazing places in the world.

Social, Moral, Spiritual and Cultural skills (SMSC)

This will be integrated throughout our topics.

Promoting our school values

Through our learning we will be learning about diversity and tolerance. We will be re-introducing our school values and incorporating them into our learning.

RE

In RE, we will be looking at Hinduism. We will be exploring the question: How might people express their devotion?

Art

Our topic this half term will be 'Life in Colour'. We will use drawing, painting and sculpture to develop and share ideas, experiences and imagination.

Computing

This half term we will focus on Programming and algorithms. . We will use technology purposefully to create, edit and program programmable devices. Also recognising common uses of information technology beyond school.

Music

In Music, we will be exploring 'Musical Me!', using our voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes.
