Our focus this half term will be invasion games (hockey and rugby).</p>	<p>In French, we will be learning how to recognise and sort nouns by gender and number, and to explain the effect this may have on an adjective. We will also be modifying sentences to use the correct articles/pronouns (un/une and il/elle) according to gender.</p>

There will also be cross-curricular writing opportunities regularly.</p>	<p>In computing, we will be focusing on <i>Coding and Online Safety</i>. Children will start to code efficiently as well as have the opportunity to simulate a physical system.</p>
