Attendance

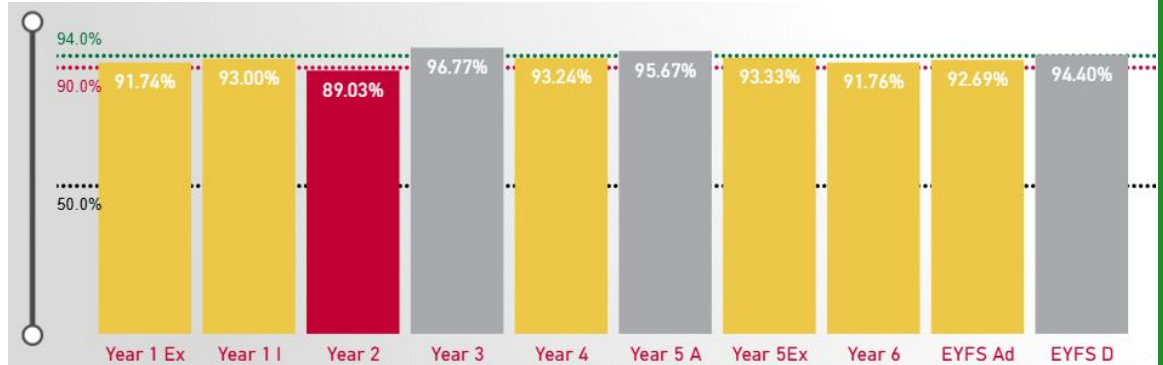
