## Year 2 Curriculum Overview (Autumn 2)

### 'Who is the fairest of them all?'

Our topic this half term is focussing on the characters in fairy tales. We will be using this topic to develop our skills in many areas! Our key subjects this half term are English, PSHE and DT.

Key vocabulary:

Once upon a time, happily ever after, magic, values, structure.

## Maths

Our daily maths sessions will focus on fluently adding and subtracting within 10, calculations within 20 and adding and subtracting two-digit numbers. We will also introduce multiplication by representing equal groups.



## Science

This term we will be exploring the microhabitats of living things and how they provide their basic needs. We will; identify and classify minibeasts, plan and carry out a scientific experiment with woodlice and investigate whether certain minibeasts prefer light or dark places.

## History

In History, we will be exploring the question 'How was school different in the past?'. We will research school life throughout the decades and then discuss and compare how things have changed over time.

## Social, Moral, Spiritual and Cultural skills (SMSC)

This will be integrated throughout our topics.

### Promoting our school values

Through our learning we will be learning about diversity and tolerance. We will be re-introducing our school values and incorporating them into our learning.

## RE

In RE, we will be looking at Christianity and God. We will be exploring the question: Why do Christians say Jesus is the 'Light of the World'?

## DT

We will be using Goldilocks and the Three Bears as inspiration to build Baby Bear a brand new chair.

## Computing

This half term we will focus on Online Safety. We will also look at Spreadsheets and how to use technology to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content.

## Music

In Music, we will experiment with Orchestral Instruments, creating, selecting and combining sounds using the inter-related dimensions of music.

## Art

We will increase our confidence when cutting, shaping and joining paper, card and malleable materials.
